Do you have pain in your testicles (balls), pelvis (lower tummy) or anus (bum/bottom)?	YES	NO

Do you have any unusual discharge from your vagina, penis or anus (bum/bottom)? (vaginal discharge is often normal)	YES	NO
Have you had any recent unexpected bleeding from your vagina or any bleeding from your penis or anus?	YES	NO

Do you have lumps, bumps or rashes on your vagina, penis or anus that weren't there before?	YES	NO
Have you had sex with someone new or anyone who may have had sex with others in the last 2 weeks?	YES	NO

STI checks are best done at least 2 weeks after sexual intercourse of concern.

You may choose to go ahead and self-test now or book an appointment in 2 weeks' time.
